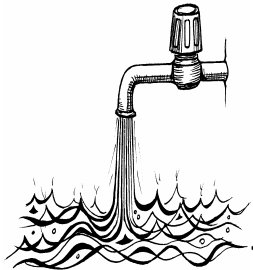
HCPT Youth Group
